THE LEMON PRESS LIMITED ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY



The management and all who work at The Lemon Press Limited are committed to the care of the environment and the prevention of pollution.

The company ensures that all its activities are carried out in the conformance with the relevant environmental legislation (and any guidance issued by the trade association the BPIF).

The company seeks to minimize waste arising, promote recycling, reduce energy consumption, reduce harmful emissions and, where possible to work with suppliers who themselves have environmental policies.

In order to drive our philosophy of continual improvement, and to reduce the potential for pollution, the following objectives will be pursued as far as is reasonably practicable:

- Recycling of paper waste and plates
- Monitoring the use of energy and natural resources
- Reduce the quantity of waste going to landfill
- Effective disposal of non-biodegradable substances

To ensure the achievement of the above commitments, the company has implemented an environmental management system which meets the requirements of the ISO 14001:2004 international standard.

The Lemon Press Ltd. monitors, as part of its regular company improvement meetings, the environmental system/policy. A full review is conducted each year. The aim is to continually improve not just the achievement of this policy but also the company's impact on the environment.

This policy and the obligations and responsibilities required by the environmental management system have been communicated to all employees.
